### **JUDGING –**

Top priority will be given to those entries that are considered, "Theme Floats", which are entries completely covered with some type of covering and portrays our theme image, "Soaring Spirit". Consideration will be given to the amount of THEME EFFORT, THEME DETAIL, PRESENTATION & ENTHUSIASM and EFFORT used in creating the entry.

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## **2009 Rodeo Parade**

### RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ALL ENTRIES WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE PARADE COMMITTEE. Any entry that does not conform to these rules and regulations will be eliminated from consideration. All decisions of the Parade Committee are final. Entry fees submitted by an entry that is not approved will be refunded.
2. Please include a recent photograph or sketch of your parade entry. Photos/sketches will not be returned. PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT THIS IS A "FAMILY" PARADE AND ALL ENTRIES SHOULD BE "G" RATED.
- 3. BE SURE TO INCLUDE YOUR 15-SECOND ENTRY SCRIPT TO BE USED BY THE PUBLIC ADDRESS ANNOUNCERS ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE.**
4. Your parade position and final details will be sent in mid-June. Numbers to be prominently displayed on your entry will be issued on the morning of the parade. If your entry is a group, please be certain that all members of the group know their position number and all the necessary details prior to parade day.
5. The parade pace is 90 steps per minute and will be enforced by official pacers. Because of the number of entries in the parade and the time that the parade is allowed, there cannot be delays or stops to perform.
6. Unless a waiver is obtained from the Parade Chairman, sign letters should not be larger than 18 inches. Advertising, identification of floats and themes should be kept to a minimum and be in good taste.
7. Any entry not complying with the rules and regulations as set forth by the parade committee will NOT be allowed to participate in the parade (or in future parades).
8. All float entries with electronic equipment (i.e. speakers, amplifiers) should carry a fire extinguisher on or in the vehicle or float
9. Children under the age of ten (10) years must be accompanied by an adult.
10. If you will be discharging a weapon – NO LIVE ROUNDS!
11. For the safety of everyone candy or other items may be distributed by parade walkers only at curbside along the parade route. ***Throwing items is prohibited!***
12. Judging of ALL entries will be conducted during the parade.
13. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE PERMITTED!
14. Entries should arrive at your assigned staging area by 7:00am to receive numbers and locate their positions.

**– – ATTENTION – –**

**Safety Rules 2009**

1. Children under the age of ten (10) will not be allowed to ride on a horse alone during the parade. Child must be accompanied by an adult walking or riding.
2. All Children under the age of ten (10) and riding on a horse **MUST** wear a protective helmet.
3. Children under the age of twelve (12) must be “seated” on any and all types of floats/vehicles.
4. Children ages twelve (12) and older and “standing” on a float/vehicle must have something stable to hold on to for balance.
5. Any vehicle being pulled by a horse(s) <includes, but not limited to a wagon, stage coach or trailer> must have an adult walking along side or riding with the horse(s) to help control the horse(s) throughout the parade route. A safety rope/out-rigging attached to the team lead to stop the team.
6. Only one (1) rider per horse.

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
