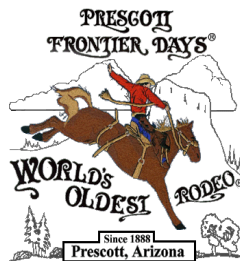

**Miss Prescott Frontier Days® Pageant Application**

To be eligible to hold the position of Miss Prescott Frontier Days® Queen, you must be a young woman between 18 and 23 years of age. Senior Court must be a young woman between 15 and 17 years of age.

Contestants must have reached their category ages by June 7, 2009, and meet the following requirements:

- Have not previously held the title for which you are applying.
- Have never been married and/or pregnant.
- Queen and Senior Court must be a resident of Yavapai County, AZ or the Arizona cities of Wickenburg, Williams, Parks or Bellemont. (Full time residents attending school outside of Yavapai County are considered eligible, providing they agree to meet appearance requirements established by the Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. Queen Committee.)
- With this application the applicant must provide the Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. Queen Committee with a copy of her birth certificate and proof of health insurance.
- Applicants must have access to a horse and horse trailer appropriate for their positions.
- Completed and signed applications must be accompanied by a non-refundable check in the amount of \$60.00 made payable to Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. (The fee will cover the cost of photos, contestant materials, etc.)
- Selected contestants shall provide proof of insurance liability for the crowns, buckles, chaps and saddles that they will use.

Miss Prescott Frontier Days® 2010 will be awarded a \$1,000.00 scholarship to the school of her choice, a saddle and a Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. trophy buckle. The scholarship shall be used by 2012. The 2010 Senior Court will be awarded \$300.00 in U.S. Savings Bonds and a Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. trophy buckle.

Before competing for any pageant title, there are many things to take into consideration. Being a member of Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. Royalty is a JOB. This isn't just an opportunity to look pretty on a horse (although you will have your share of that!). It is an opportunity to represent and promote the World's Oldest Rodeo® and the western way of life. Your top priority is to represent this rodeo in a very classy and professional manner. We have high expectations of our royalty and expect them to be "true queens" at all times. As Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. Royalty, you will be required to attend rodeos, parades, membership meetings, grand openings, nursing home visits, charity events, etc., all the while promoting our World's Oldest Rodeo® with grace, style and class. This is a huge commitment that will require a lot of your weekends and many of your weeknights.

Being a rodeo queen will likely require out of pocket expenses. While Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. will provide some monetary help with travel expenses, we want you to come in fully aware of the potential cost you may incur including wardrobe, travel for your family and meals beyond your allowed budget.

Wardrobe is a large expense. This pageant does set forth wardrobe guidelines and requirements. We will go over them in full detail at orientation. You are expected to add color and pageantry to our rodeo and we want you to stand out. Also, all pants must be made by Wrangler, a major PRCA Rodeo sponsor.

We will offer a Queen's closet clothing sale at Orientation. There are a lot of former queens selling their clothes and this will be a good place to look for a pageant dress, horsemanship outfit, arena shirts, hats, boots, etc. all at reasonable prices.

Please bring the horse you will be using for the pageant!**

During Orientations, we will review the pageant study guide, wardrobe, hair and make-up trends; answer any questions you have and help you prepare any way we can. Further instructions on photos will be given. Photos are to be taken on Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, 2009 @ 2:00pm at A Portrait Park by J. Orientation is a time for questions. Please bring all that you have. We do not want any contestant leaving orientation with uncertainties.

Orientation will include a **horsemanship clinic for you and your competition horse**. You will be doing a practice pattern and will be critiqued in an effort to prepare you for pageant day. Our competition requires each contestant to do a flag presentation run on her horse. **Please make sure your horse can carry a flag before you come to orientation.** We are here to help you improve but none of us have the time to train your horse. As a contestant, you are required to carry sponsor flags during our rodeo performances. Please bring a flag boot. If you do not own one at this time, please contact Chairman Crystal Killian at 928-713-0405.

Remember, you are being judged at all times (not just on Pageant Day) and cooperation, enthusiasm, and punctuality are a large part of being Miss Prescott Frontier Days®.

We have a remarkable committee working hard to ensure your success and we are all cheering for you. We look forward to meeting you and encourage you to contact us with any additional questions you may have. The Pageant Chairman is Crystal Killian and the Assistant Chairman is Raenell Killian. Scholarship Pageant Rules  
2009 Competition**

- Contestants will vote by secret ballot to choose a Congeniality award winner.
- All decisions of the judges are final.
- There will be Special Awards presented to the first runners-up in each age category, and to the individual winners of horsemanship, speech, modeling, photogenic, and interview.

**General Rules**

1. Harassment and arguing between contestants and families **will not** be tolerated. Lady-like and good sportsmanship behavior will be expected at all times!
2. A contestant must file any grievance. No grievance from parents, guardians, trainers, etc. will be acknowledged. The grievance must be handwritten, signed and delivered to the grievance committee and the Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. President, within 3 hours of the event being protested. Contestants will not receive any point deduction for filing a grievance.
3. Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. welcomes and encourages the presence of parents, relatives, and friends of the contestants. However, we ask that you not distract the contestants during pageant events. Parents will be allowed in the contestant's room during the Pageant as permitted by the Pageant Officials.
4. Behavior of Miss Prescott Frontier Days® Contestants during public appearances related to the pageant must be beyond reproach at all times. No profanity or abusive language will be tolerated, nor will the use of tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs, and absolutely no abuse toward horses. Contestants shall exhibit professionalism at all times. These standards shall be upheld not only by contestants, but parents, trainers, and anyone else associated with the Prescott Frontier Days®, Inc. Queen Pageant.
5. No contestant will be allowed to participate in any Pageant Event unless they have returned their Official Waiver & appropriate insurance information.
